

## TYPHOID FEVER

Typhoid is an acute infectious disease caused by the bacterium Salmonella Typhi in the gastrointestinal tract.

The disease usually occurs in the summer (from June to September) in areas with poor sanitation.



## ! Symptoms



Fever that starts low and gradually increases, then continuously high at 39-41°C (plateau phase)



Digestive disorders: anorexia and constipation,



Headache, fatigue and insomnia.



A rash of 2-4 millimeters may appear on the abdomen, lower chest or hips.

## Prevention



Get vaccinated.



Environmental sanitation, food hygiene and protection of clean water sources.



Treatment of healthy carriers.



Isolate and dispose of the patient's waste.
