

ATOPIC DERMATIS



Atopic dermatitis is a common dermatological disease that occurs with the hypersensitivity reactions of the immune system to allergens such as dirt, pollen, insects, animal hair...The cause of the disease is quite complicated and related to the immune system inside the body.

(!) Symptoms



Itching, swelling and redness.



Tiny blisters appear, leaking fluid if popped.



Allergies often start on the face, hands, eyelids or neck.



In severe cases, reactions may be anorexia, fever, fatigue...



The appearance of dark or red/brown patches on the skin.

Prevention



Daily clean and keep the body warm.



Regularly clean the house, pillows, utensils.



Moisturize and carefully protect your skin when going outside.



Wear comfortable clothes.
